05 01 03 (*)	Tank bottom sludges
05 01 05 (*)	Oil spills
05 01 06 (*)	Oily sludges from maintenance operations of the plant or equipment
05 01 09 (*)	Sludges from on-site effluent treatment containing hazardous substances
13 04 01 (*)	Bilge oils from inland navigation
13 04 02 (*)	Bilge oils from jetty sewers
13 04 03 (*)	Bilge oils from other navigation
13 05 01 (*)	Solids from grit chambers and oil/water separators
13 05 02 (*)	Sludge from oil/water separators
13 05 03 (*)	Interceptor sludge
13 05 06 (*)	Oil from oil/water separators
13 05 07 (*)	Oily water from oil/water separators
13 05 08 (*)	Mixtures of wastes from grit chambers and oil/water separators
13 07 01 (*)	Fuel oil and diesel

16 07 08 (*)	Wastes containing oil
19 02 07 (*)	Oil and concentrates from separation
19 02 08 (*)	Liquid combustible wastes containing dangerous substances
19 02 10	Combustible wastes other than those mentioned in 19 02 08 and 19 02 09

RECOVERY AND DISPOSAL OPERATIONS	
D9	Physic-chemical treatment not specified elsewhere which results in final compounds or mixtures which are disposed of by any of the operations numbered D1 to D12. _ Operations concerning the liquid phase treatment, with a view to its elimination.
D15	Storage pending any of the operations numbered D1 to D14 (excluding temporary storage pending collection on the site where it is produced). _ Operations on temporary storage of solid waste contaminated with hydrocarbons and oily sludge.
R9	Oil refining or other uses of oil. _ Operations concerning the production and enhancement of the fuel mix through physical phase separation and heating.
